Međunarodno gudačko natjecanje Rudolf Matz je glazbena manifestacija koja se održava bienalno, sa sudionicima iz čitavoga svijeta, te najuglednijim svjetskim i hrvatskim glazbenicima i glazbenim pedagozima kao članovima ocjenjivačkoga suda.

Ovo natjecanje, jedinstveno u nas i u svijetu svoju popularnost zahvaljuje specifičnim propozicijama – to je jedino natjecanje u Hrvatskoj koje je namijenjeno violinistima, violistima, violončelistima i kontrabasistima koji se natječu u istoj konkurenciji, čime je naglasak pri ocjenjivanju stavljen prvenstveno na kvalitetu izvedbe, muziciranje i talent, a ne toliko na specifične tehničke vještine na svakom pojedinom instrumentu kao na ostalim natjecanjima. Još jedna specifičnost je to što nema dobnih kategorija, već je kategorizacija prema godinama učenja instrumenta.

Nakon svake kategorije, članovi žirija održavaju radionice sa svim zainteresiranim kandidatima. Natjecanje je utemeljeno 1981.g. kada je započelo s radom kao malo čeličićko natjecanje namijenjeno najmlađima. Zahvaljujući svojim specifičnostima i posebnoj atmosferi, natjecanje je iz godine u godinu postajalo sve popularnije da bi se 2006. preselilo u Dubrovnik, naraslo do međunarodnih okvira i proširilo se na violiniste i violiste. Na natjecanju 2010. bilo je 70-tak kandidata iz 12 zemalja.

Od 2013. natjecanje se održava u Čakovcu, a od 2016. godine na natjecanju mogu sudjelovati i kontrabasisti.

International String Competition Rudolf Matz is a respectable musical event held biennially with participants from all over the world and internationally most prominent musicians and music pedagogues as members of the jury.

This competition, unique in the world made its popularity thanks to specific propositions – it is the only competition in Croatia, which is intended for violinists, violists, cellists and double bass players who are competing in the same category, whereby the emphasis is placed primarily in evaluating the quality of performance, music and talent, rather than on specific technical skills on each instrument as in other competitions. Another specificity is that there are no age categories – it is categorized by the years of learning the instrument.

After each category, the Jury members hold workshops with interested candidates.

The competition was established in 1981, when it started as a small cello competition designed for the youngest. Thanks to its characteristics and the special atmosphere of the competition it is becoming every year more and more popular. So, in 2006. the Competition moved to Dubrovnik, has grown to an international level and expanded to the violinists and violists. In the 2010 Competition there were around 70 candidates from 12 countries.

From 2013. Competition is held in Čakovec, and since 2016 double bass players can also participate in the competition.

Glazbeno obrazovanje u Čakovcu svoj početak bilježi 8. siječnja 1946. kada je odobreno osnivanje prve Muzičke škole u Čakovcu koja je u to vrijeme djelovala u vrlo skromnim uvjetima – između ostalog i u prostorijama nekadašnje konjušnice, te sa svega nekoliko učitelja i dvadesetak učenika.

Od 30. lipnja 1954. škola postaje Muzički tečaj Čakovec, 13. ožujka 1964. tečaj postaje Područno odjeljenje Muzičke škole u Varaždinu, a 13. srpnja 1972. odjel se izdvaja i postaje Osnovna muzička škola Čakovec pri Radničkom sveučilištu Čakovec. Odlukom Skupštine Međimurske županije 27. rujna 1995. izdvajanjem iz Radničkog sveučilišta škola postaje Osnovna umjetnička škola Čakovec i seli na sadašnju lokaciju u ul. V. Nazora 14 u Čakovcu, 2003. godine počinje s radom i Baletni odjel, a 23. listopada 2006. mijenja naziv u Umjetničku školu Miroslav Magdalenić Čakovec.

U sastavu škole je Osnovna glazbena škola, Osnovna baletna škola, Glazbena igraonica i Glazbeni tečaj, a djeluje na pet lokacija: Čakovec – Glazbeni odjel i Baletni odjel, Mursko Središće, Prelog i Donji Kraljevec, a nastava se odvija na 10 solističkih instrumenata, 2 teorijska predmeta i skupog muziciranja (Puhački orkestar, ansambl harmonika, gitara, limenih puhača, drvenih puhača, 3 komorna zbora i veliki dječji zbor).

Škola u suradnji s Hrvatskim društvom gudačkih pedagoga i pod pokroviteljstvom Grada Čakovca bienalno organizira eminentno *Međunarodno gudačko natjecanje Rudolf Matz*, održavaju se produkcije klasa, odjela, koncerti škole uz veliku podršku osnivača – Grada Čakovca. Učenici i djelatnici škole aktivno sudjeluju u kulturnom, glazbenom i javnom životu grada i županije. Učenici i škole redovito sudjeluju na regionalnim, državnim i međunarodnim natjecanjima gdje osvajaju izuzetno vrijedne i visoke nagrade, a glazbeni pedagozi vrijedno rade na svom stručnom usavršavanju kako bi savjesno i odgovorno njegovali talente i vještine mlađih glazbenika, a time i postizali zavidne rezultate. Iz okrilja škole izašao je velik broj glazbenih i plesnih pedagoga, izvođača, solista, članova ansambala i orkestara, koji svoje umjetničke početke zahvaljuju upravo ovoj Školi. Nastavljajući svoje srednjoškolsko i visokoškolsko obrazovanje, stječući zvanja i visoke titule, odgajajući nove naraštaje glazbenika u našoj i drugim školama; bivši učenici svjedoče o kontinuitetu glazbenog i plesnog obrazovanja, kvaliteti rada i predanosti glazbenih i plesnih pedagoga – članova kolektiva naše škole.

Music education in Čakovec began on January 8, 1946 when the establishment of the first Music School in Čakovec was approved. The school operated at that time in very modest conditions – among other things in the premises of the former horse-stable, with only a few teachers and twenty students.

On June 30, 1954 the school became the Music Course Čakovec and on March 13, 1964 the course became the Regional Department of Music School in Varaždin, but on July 13, 1972 the department separated from the school in Varaždin and became the Primary Music School Čakovec at the Workers' University of Čakovec. The school then separated from the Workers' University and became the Primary Art School Čakovec with the decision of the County Assembly of Medimurje on September 27, 1995. It moved to its present location Vladimira Nazora 14 in Čakovec and in 2003 the Ballet Department started its activities. On October 23, 2006 the name of the school was changed to the Art School Miroslav Magdalenić Čakovec.

The school consists of the Primary Music School, Primary Ballet School, Music Playroom and Music Course, and it operates in 5 locations: Čakovec – Music Department and Ballet Department, Mursko Središće, Prelog and Donji Kraljevec. The teaching involves 10 solo instruments, 2 theoretical subjects and collective playing (Wind Orchestra, accordion, guitar, brass and woodwind ensembles, 3 chamber choirs and a large children's choir).

In cooperation with the Croatian Society of String Pedagogues and under the auspices of the City of Čakovec, the School biennially organizes the renowned *International Rudolf Matz Competition*. Public performances, departmental and school concerts are also held with the great support of the founder – the City of Čakovec, and the students and school staff actively participate in cultural, musical and public life of the city and the county. The students regularly participate in regional, state and international competitions, where they win extremely valuable and high prizes, and music teachers are well-versed in their professional training and they conscientiously nurture the talents and skills of young musicians and thus achieve ambitious results. Numerous music and dance pedagogues, performers, soloists, members of the ensemble and orchestra have been students here, and they thank this school for their artistic beginnings. By continuing their secondary and tertiary education, by gaining vocations and high titles, educating new generations of musicians in our and other schools, our former students are witnessing the continuity of music and dance education, the quality of work and commitment of music and dance pedagogues – members of our school staff.

PREDSJEDNICA



Dobrila Berković-Magdalenić rođena je u Zagrebu, Hrvatska, gdje je diplomirala kod profesora Milana Nagyija na Muzičkoj akademiji u Zagrebu. Svoj život posvećuje poučavanju, dugi niz godina voditeljica je Odsjeka za čelo svih glazbenih škola u Hrvatskoj, kao i predsjednica Udruženja hrvatskih pedagoga gudača (nacionalni ogranač ESTA).

Tijekom 47 godina karijere poučavanja, njeni studenti ističu se i osvajaju nagrade na više od stotinu nacionalnih i internacionalnih natjecanja; među mnogima na Junior Tchaikovsky natjecanju 1995. – prva nagrada; Adam's natjecanje, Novi Zeland – prva nagrada; Premio Stradivari Caruana, Milano 1999. – prva nagrada; Antonio Janigro natjecanje 1996. – 2. nagrada; ARD Minhen 2000. -2. nagrada; Rostropovich natjecanje 1997. – treća nagrada... kao i nastupima širom svijeta.

Brojni učenici profesorice Berković-Magdalenić nastavili su studij kod svjetski poznatih čelista i učitelja poput E. Schoenfeld, (USC Los Angeles); A. Peled, (Peabody, Baltimore); P. Down (Eastman); N. Ružević (UNT Denton, Texas); D. Geringas, (Hochschule Berlin); A. Meneses, (Basel); J. P. Meinz (Berlin); M. Flaksman, (Manheim); V. Dešpalj, (Zagreb)... i vodeći su čelisti u mnogim orkestrima. Profesorica Berković-Magdalenić utemeljila je i suorganizatorica je Međunarodnog gudačkog natjecanja Rudolf Matz i Međunarodnog natjecanja čelista Antonio Janigro, oba od velikog značaja kulturno-glazbenih događanja u Hrvatskoj.

Kao predsjednica Hrvatskog ogranka ESTA osnovala je UPBEAT (Međunarodnu ljetnu glazbenu školu) koja uključuje majstorske tečajeve i radionice za glazbenike i učenike, kao i festival komorne glazbe. Svake godine preko 500 mladih glazbenika sudjeluje u raznolikosti radionica, vođenih poznatim glazbenim pedagozima i izvođačima, što UPBEAT svrstava u najveće događanje ovog tipa u Hrvatskoj. Dobrila Berković-Magdalenić također je ustanovala Japanski ogranač UPBEAT festival. 2007. godine postala je savjetnicom u Ministarstvu odgoja i obrazovanja, a dodijeljene su joj prestižne nagrade, priznanje istog Ministarstva kao i nagrada Ministarstva kulture. Talenti za Evropu proglašilo ju je najboljom Europskom čelu glazbenom pedagoginjom 2014. godine.

Objavivši svoj prvi udžbenik za čeliste početnike 2011., profesorica Berković-Magdalenić bavi se pripremom materijala za objavljivanje još nekoliko udžbenika.

PRESIDENT

Dobrila Berković-Magdalenić was born in Zagreb, Croatia, where she graduated with professor Milan Nagy at Zagreb Music Academy. Having devoted her life to teaching, she's been heading Cello Departments of all the music schools in Croatia for many years, as well as Croatian String Teacher's Association (national branch of ESTA).

During 47 years of her teaching career, her students have excelled and won prizes at over one hundred national and international competitions, among them Junior Tchaikovsky Competition 1995 – 1st prize; Adam's Competition, New Zealand – 1st prize, Premio Stradivari Caruana, Milano in 1999. – 1st prize, Antonio Janigro Competition 1996 – 2nd prize, ARD Munich 2000 – 2nd prize, Rostropovich Competition 1997 – 3rd prize, etc., and performed all over the world.

A number of professor Berković-Magdalenić's students went on to study with globally recognized cellists and teachers such as E. Schoenfeld, (USC Los Angeles), A. Peled, (Peabody, Baltimore), P. Down, (Eastman), N. Ružević (UNT Denton, Texas), D. Geringas, (Hochschule Berlin) A. Meneses, (Basel), J. P. Meinz, (Berlin), M. Flaksman, (Manheim), V. Dešpalj, (Zagreb) etc., and have been Principal Cellists in various orchestras. Professor Berković-Magdalenić has founded and is co-organizer of International String Competition Rudolf Matz, and International Cello Competition Antonio Janigro, both very important to cultural life in Croatia.

In 1987, as president of the Croatian branch of ESTA, she established UPBEAT (International Summer Music School), which includes masterclasses, classes for children, and Chamber Music Festival. Every year over 500 young musicians participate in a variety of classes held by world famous teachers and performers, thus making UPBEAT the biggest event of this kind in Croatia. Dobrila Berković-Magdalenić has also founded Japanese branch of UPBEAT Festival.

In 2007 she became Councilor at National Ministry of Education and received prestigious awards such as the Award of Ministry of Education, and the Award of Ministry of Culture. Talents for Europe proclaimed her best European cello teacher in 2014.

Having published her first book for beginner cellists in 2011, professor Berković-Magdalenić keeps herself busy preparing materials for several more books.



Vildana Repše, akademska glazbenica i violinistica, profesorica violine je rođena u Sarajevu, u poznatoj obitelji Smailović. Violinu je studirala u klasi profesora Dejana Bravničara na ljubljanskoj Akademiji za glazbu, gdje je i diplomirala.

Sa iznimnim interesom i uspjehom se posvećuje pedagoškom radu u Glazbenom ateljeu Tartini u Ljubljani, prvoj privatnoj glazbenoj školi u Sloveniji, koju je 1990. godine osnovala zajedno sa suprugom Repše Vladom. Autorica je više udžbenika i priručnika, predavačica je na seminarima i međunarodnim kongresima, istraživačica na području metodike sviranja na violinu i mentorica mladim učiteljima.

Kao prava obožavateljica orkestralne glazbe je svoje umjetničko djelovanje usmjerila u sviranje u orkestrima: Simfoničarima RTV Ljubljana, Slovenskoj filharmoniji, Komornom orkestru Tartini, Gudačkom ansamblu Musica ad hominem i od 2010. godine u gudačkom orkestru Camerata medica, u kojem ima ulogu koncertnog majstora.


Ima dvije kćerke: Maju i Sanju. Obje su aktivne glazbene umjetnice i pedagoginje.

Vildana Repše is the academic musician and violinist, professor of the violin, who was born in Sarajevo of a well-known family Smailović. She studied the violin with professor Dejan Bravničar at Ljubljana Music Academy, where she graduated.

With exceptional interest and success she has been devoted to teaching at Music Atelier Tartini in Ljubljana, the first private music school in Slovenia, which she and her husband Vlado Repše founded together in 1990. She is the author of several textbooks and manuals, she is the lecturer at the seminars and international congresses, she also researches the methodology of the violin playing, as well as being the mentor to young teachers.

Vildana Repše routed her artistic field of activities playing with orchestras:Ljubljana Radio-television Simphonic Orchestra, Slovene Philharmonic Orchestra, Chamber Orchestra Tartini, String Ensemble Musica ad hominem, since 2010 has been the concert master of String Orchestra Camerata medica-mostly as the result of being a real fan of orchestral music.

She has got two daughters, Maja and Sanja, who both are alert musical artists and pedagogues.



Andelko Krpan (Zagreb, 1967.) diplomirao je violinu na *Muzičkoj akademiji* u Zagrebu, u razredu Kristijana Petrovića 1989., te 1995. magistrirao na *Hochschule für Musik und darstellende Kunst* u Beču kod Dore Schwarzberg. Bio je član *Bečke komorne filharmonije* (1993. -97.), zatim član *Zagrebačkih solista* (1993. -97.), koncertni majstor *Zagrebačkih solista* (1997. -2002.), koncertni majstor *Orkestra HNK iz Zagreba* (2002. -2006.), a od 1995. do danas predaje violinu na *Muzičkoj akademiji* u Zagrebu. Jedan je od utemeljitelja i prvi violinist Gudačkoga kvarteta *Sebastian*.

Osvorio je prvu nagradu na Međunarodnom violinističkom natjecanju Alpe-Adria u Italiji (1988.), Nagradu HGZ-a (1989.), šestu nagradu na Međunarodnom violinističkom natjecanju *Václav Huml* u Zagrebu (1993.), Nagradu Muzičke omladine *Ivo Vuljević* za najboljeg mladoga glazbenika Hrvatske u 1993. godini. Godine 1999. odlikovan je *Redom Danice hrvatske s likom Marka Marulića*. 2008. dobio je nagradu *Milka Trnina* Hrvatskog društva glazbenih umjetnika za iznimne umjetničke dosege. Do sada je snimio 15 CD-a za izdavačku kuću *Croatia Records* s pijanisticom Nadom Majnarić, violistom Markom Generom i gudačkim kvartetom *Sebastian*. Dobitnik je diskografske nagrade *Porin* za CD *Hrvatske sonate* ostvaren u suradnji s pijanisticom Nadom Majnarić.

Andelko Krpan (Zagreb, 1967.) graduated in Violin at the Academy of Music in Zagreb in the class of Kristijan Petrović (1989), and went on to earn his Masters at the *Hochschule für Musik und Darstellende Kunst* in Vienna in the class of Dora Schwarzberg (1995). He has been a member of the *Vienna Chamber Philharmonic* (1989-93), then member of the *Zagreb Soloists* (1993-97), orchestra leader of the *Zagreb Soloists* (1997-2002), concertmaster of *Croatian National Theatre Orchestra of Zagreb* (2002-2006), and has been teaching Violin at the Academy of Music in Zagreb since 1995. He is one of the founders and the first violinist of the *Sebastian String Quartet*.

Andelko Krpan won first prize at the Alpe-Adria International Violinist Contest in Italy (1988), the Croatian Music Institute prize (1989), sixth prize at the *Václav Huml* International Violinist Contest in Zagreb (1993), and the *Ivo Vuljević Music Youth* prize as the best young Croatian musician in 1993. In 1999, he was officially decorated with the *Croatian Morning Star Order with the Image of Marko Marulić*. He received the Croatian Society of Music Artists *Milka Trnina* Award in 2008 for his exceptional artistic achievements. He received the *Porin Prize* for the CD *Croatian Sonatas* recorded in collaboration with the pianist, Nada Majnarić.



Nikola Ružević rođen je u Zagrebu 1969. godine. Prvu poduku violončela dobio je u rodnom gradu kod profesorice Dobrile Berković-Magdalenić. Tijekom školovanja osvojio je brojne nagrade na natjecanjima učenika i studenata glazbe. Svoj prvi recital održao je s petnaest godina.

Kada je imao šesnaest godina, dobio je stipendiju iz SAD-a gdje je otišao na usavršavanje kod profesora Michaela Flaksmana i profesorice Eleonore Schoenfeld. Diplomirao je na Sveučilištu Južne Kalifornije u Los Angelesu 1992. Dok je boravio u SAD-u, osvojio je nagradu Rose Pollack, nagradu Fresno Musical Club i državno natjecanje simfonija Colorado. Pohađao je majstorske tečajeve Janigra, Taraspulskog, Varge, Dešpalja, Sondeckienea i Kvarteta Bartók.

Kao solist Nikola Ružević je svirao sa Zagrebačkom filharmonijom, Zagrebačkim solistima, Engleskim orkestrom mlađih, Baden-Badenskom filharmonijom nastupajući u Hrvatskoj, drugim europskim zemljama i SAD-u. Nikola Ružević bio je predavač na Sveučilištu Južne Kalifornije, Muzičkoj akademiji Sveučilišta u Zagrebu, Festivalu komorne glazbe Apple Hill i bio je voditelj violončelista u sljedećim orkestrima: Orkestar Zagrebačke filharmonije, Filharmonija Fresno, Opera Fresno i Opera ceha u Los Angelesu. Posljednjih 15 godina radi kao profesor na Sveučilištu North Texas.

Nikola Ružević was born in Zagreb in 1969. He received his first cello lessons in his hometown with professor Dobrila Berković-Magdalenić. During his schooling he won many prizes at competitions for pupils and students of music. He gave his first recital at the age of fifteen. When he was sixteen, he was given a scholarship by the USA where he went to study under professor Michael Flaksman and professor Eleonore Schoenfeld. He graduated from the University of Southern California in Los Angeles in 1992. While in the USA, he won the Rose Pollack Award, Fresno Musical Club Award and Colorado Symphony National Competition. He attended master classes with Janigro, Taraspulski, Varga, Dešpalj, Sondeckiene, and the Bartók Quartet. As a soloist, Nikola Ružević has played with the Zagreb Philharmonic Orchestra, Zagreb Soloists, English Youth Orchestra, Baden-Baden Philharmonic appearing in Croatia, other European countries and the USA.

Nikola Ruzevic has held teaching positions at the University of Southern California, University of Zagreb Academy of Music, Apple Hill Chamber Music Festival, and principal cellist positions in the following orchestras: Zagreb Philharmonic Orchestra, Fresno Philharmonic, Fresno Opera, and Los Angeles Guild Opera. The last 15 years he act as a professor at University of North Texas.



Violist **Milan Čunko** (rođen u Varaždinu 29. prosinca 1957.) na Muzičkoj akademiji u Zagrebu diplomirao je violinu u razredu prof. Milana Tarbuka i violu u razredu prof. Daniela Thunea. Bavi se glazbenom pedagogijom, prvo u glazbenim školama *Vatroslav Lisinski* u Bjelovaru, potom *Pavao Markovac* u Zagrebu i na kraju na *Muzičkoj akademiji* u Zagrebu (od 1997. predavač, od 1998. docent, od 2004. izvanredni profesor, od 2010. u zvanju redovitog profesora, a od 2016. u trajnom zvanju redovitog profesora za violu). Do sada je u njegovom razredu diplomirao 26 studenata. Kao predavač viole i komorne glazbe predavao je na majstorskim tečajevima **STRINGS ONLY!** u Zadru, 1997., 1998. i 1999. i na Međunarodnom seminaru komorne glazbe *Farra d'Isonzo* u Italiji 2001. – 2008. te u Grožnjanu od 2011. do danas.

Kao orkestralni glazbenik bio je član, potom i solo-violist Zagrebačke filharmonije od 1991. do 1997, zatim voda viola Hrvatskog komornog orkestra do 1994, te član ansambla Zagrebački solisti od 1996. do 2000. Jedan je od osnivača Varaždinskog komornog orkestra, gdje također vodi dionicu viola i član je Umljetničkoga vijeća od osnivanja 1994. do 2020., a od 2007.-2011. šef orkestra. U komornom muziciranju surađuje s pijanistima Veljkom Glodićem, Miroslavom Ghera, Đordjem Stanetijem, Ljubomirom Gašparovićem i Majom Bakrač, Zagrebačkim kvartetom, Gudačkim kvartetom Sebastian, Zagrebačkim puhačkim kvintetom i drugima. Kao solist nastupao je uz Hrvatski komorni orkestar, Zagebačku filharmoniju, Simfonijski orkestar HRT, Zagrebačke soliste, Varaždinski komorni orkestar, Hrvatski barokni ansambl, Zadarski komorni orkestar, Šibenski komorni orkestar te orkestar *Slovenicum* iz Ljubljane. S klarinetistom Milkom Pravdićem i pijanistom Veljkom Glodićem utemeljio je Trio *Egmont*.

S violinistom Jožetom Haluzom i violončelistom Krešimirom Lazarom djelovao je u ansamblu 3+. Svirao je i u deutima s violinistima Karlom S. Fiom i Andelkom Krpanom. Potaknuo je nastanak i prvi izveo desetak djela hrvatskih skladatelja (F. Parać, M. Tarbuk, A. Klobučar, L. Župaović, Z. Juranić, T. Uhlik i A. Igrec).

Violist **Milan Čunko** (born in Varaždin on December 29, 1957) graduated from the Music Academy in Zagreb in the class of prof. Milan Tarbuk and viola in the class of prof. Daniel Thune. He is engaged in music pedagogy, first at the music schools of Vatroslav Lisinski in Bjelovar, then Pavao Markovac in Zagreb and finally at the Academy of Music in Zagreb (since 1997 lecturer, since 1998 assistant professor, since 2004 associate professor, since 2010 in the position of regular professor, and since 2016 in the permanent position of full professor for viola). So far, 26 students have graduated in his class. As a teacher of viola and chamber music, he taught at STRINGS ONLY master classes! in Zadar, 1997, 1998 and 1999 and at the Farra d'Isonzo International Chamber Music Seminar in Italy in 2001-2008 and in Grožnjan from 2011 to the present.

As an orchestral musician, he was a member and then solo violist of the Zagreb Philharmonic from 1991 to 1997, then viola leader of the Croatian Chamber Orchestra until 1994, and a member of the Zagreb Soloists ensemble from 1996 to 2000. He is one of the founders of the Varaždin Chamber Orchestra, where he also leads the viola section and is a member of the Artistic Council from 1994 to 2020, and from 2007-2011. head of the orchestra. In chamber music, he collaborates with pianists Veljko Glodić, Miroslav Ghera, Đorđe Stanetti, Ljubomir Gašparović and Maja Bakrač, the Zagreb Quartet, the Sebastian String Quartet, the Zagreb Wind Quintet and others. As a soloist, he performed with the Croatian Chamber Orchestra, Zagebac Philharmonic, HRT Symphony Orchestra, Zagreb Soloists, Varaždin Chamber Orchestra, Croatian Baroque Ensemble, Zadar Chamber Orchestra, Sibenik Chamber Orchestra and Slovenian Orchestra from Ljubljana. He founded Trio Egmont with clarinetist Milko Pravdić and pianist Veljko Glodić.

He worked in the ensemble 3+ with violinist Jože Haluza and cellist Krešimir Lazar. He also played in duets with violinists Karlo S. Fio and Andelko Krpan. As a soloist and in collaboration with the Varaždin Chamber Orchestra, the HRT Symphony Orchestra, the Egmont Trio and pianists Miroslava Ghera, Đorđe Stanetti and Maja Bakrač, he made a number of recordings for Croatian Radio and Television. He performed as a soloist with eminent artists: G. Caussé, B. Paradžik, M. Korunić, A. Andrušenko, A. Milošev, A. Krpan, M. Genero, T. Schneider, S. Mateić, S. Krstić. As a soloist, he performed with conductors such as K. Ono, P. Dešpalj, M. Tarbuk, U. Lajovic, I. Repušić, M. Letonja, Z. Juranić, etc. He encouraged the creation and was the first to perform a dozen works by Croatian composers (F. Parać, M. Tarbuk, A. Klobučar, L. Župaović, Z. Juranić, T. Uhlik and A. Igrec).



Domagoj Gušićić (Zagreb, 1982.) diplomirao je klavir na Muzičkoj akademiji u Zagrebu i usavršavao se u klasi Đure Tikvice.

Kao solist nastupao je diljem Hrvatske te u brojnim europskim zemljama, Rusiji i SADu. Posljednih godina aktivan je primarno kao komorni i orkestralni pijanist, u kojem svojstvu surađuje s nizom eminentnih hrvatskih i stranih umjetnika. Član je ansambla "Max Bruch trio", "Trio Op. 1" i OKTOSa. Također djeluje kao jedan od orkestralnih pijanista Simfonijskog orkestra Hrvatske radiotelevizije te Zagrebačke filharmonije.

Nastupao je kao solist uz pratnju Zagrebačke filharmonije, Simfonijskog orkestra Muzičke akademije, Zagrebačkog omladinskog komornog orkestra. Sudjelovao je na brojnim pijanističkim i komornim festivalima, među kojima se ističu recitali na međunarodnim festivalima Nei suoni dei luoghi, Vareš Classic Festivalu s ansamblom WISE, festivalu "Dubrovnik u pozno ljeto" u Kneževom dvoru, festivalu "Musica Maxima", MAG Sezoni te na Fermata Festivalu na Korčuli.

Od 2008. član je Hrvatskog društva glazbenih umjetnika, a od 2012. stalno je zaposlen na Muzičkoj akademiji kao umjetnički suradnik.

Domagoj Guščić (Zagreb, 1982) received his graduate and postgraduate degrees from Academy of Music, University of Zagreb, where he studied under Prof. Đuro Tikvica.

Domagoj performed extensively as a solo pianist throughout Croatia, Europe, Russia and USA. Lately he's mostly active as a chamber and orchestral pianist; he regularly collaborates with a plethora of eminent Croatian and international artists. He's a founding member of Max Bruch trio, and a member of Ensemble OKTOS and Trio Op. 1. He also collaborates with Croatian Radio Television Symphony Orchestra and Zagreb Philharmonic Orchestra as an orchestral pianist.

As a soloist, Domagoj performed with Zagreb Philharmonic Orchestra, Academy of Music Symphony Orchestra and ZOKOR. He was a guest performer and lecturer at many piano and chamber music festivals, including "Nei suoni dei luoghi", VAREŠ Classic Festival, "Dubrovnik u pozno ljeto", "Musica Maxima", MAG Season and Fermata Festival.

Domagoj has been a member of Croatian Society of Music Artists since 2008. He's currently employed at the Academy of Music, University of Zagreb as a collaborative pianist.



David Vuković (Čakovec, 1996.) klavir je počeo učiti u klasi prof. Daniela Maria Novaka u Umjetničkoj školi Miroslav Magdalenić u Čakovcu, a obrazovanje nastavio u klasi prof. Lee Šantek u Glazbenoj školi u Varaždinu. Diplomirao je 2021. na Muzičkoj akademiji u Zagrebu u klasi profesora Đorda Stanettija s najvećom pohvalom (*summa cum laude*), a akademsku godinu 2018./19. proveo je na Musik und Kunst Privatuniversität der Stadt Wien u Beču u klasi prof. Doris Adam kao stipendista Erasmus+ programa. Dobitnik je niza nagrada od kojih se ističu prve nagrade na državnim natjecanjima HDGPP-a u disciplini klavir solo i glasovirska dva, Specijalna nagrada Hrvatskog društva skladatelja za najbolju izvedbu zadane skladbe hrvatskog autora na 9. *EPTA međunarodnom natjecanju za mlade pijaniste* u Osijeku, te dvije prve nagrade na međunarodnom natjecanju *Memorijal Jurica Murai* u Varaždinu. Korepeticijom se počeo baviti nakon studija najprije kao vanjski suradnik na Muzičkoj akademiji u Zagrebu, a od 2022. radi kao nastavnik korepeticije u Glazbenoj školi u Varaždinu.

David Vuković (Čakovec, 1996) started learning piano in the class of prof. Daniel Mario Novak in Art Shool Miroslav Magdalenić Čakovec and continued his education in the class of prof. Lea Šantek in Music School in Varaždin. He graduated in 2021 from Zagreb Academy of Music in the class of prof. Đorđe Stanetti with the highest honor (*summa cum laude*) and spent the academic year 2018/19 at the Music and Arts Private University of Vienna in the class of prof. Doris Adam as a scholar of the Erasmus+ program.

He is a winner of numerous awards, most distinctive being first prizes on the HDGPP national competitions in the disciplines of piano solo and piano duo, Croatian composers society award for the best performance of the compulsory work by a Croatian composer at the *9th EPTA competition for young pianists* in Osijek and two first prizes at the *Memorijal Jurica Murai* in Varaždin. He has also received the Rector's Award for the performance of Beethoven's 4th Piano Concerto with the Zagreb Philharmonic Orchestra, and he performed with the Zagreb Soloists and the Varaždin Chamber Orchestra.

During his studies, David intensively started to engage with chamber music, mostly as a member of the Trio Eusebius (along with violinist Eva Šulić Brajčić and cellist Tonka Javorović), with whom he achieved significant success by winning the Papandopulo, Ferdo Livadić and Darko Lukić competitions, as well as notable performances at festival such as Dubrovnik Summer Festival, Osor Musical Evenings, Samobor Music Festival, Croatian Music Festival in Vienna, Evenings on Grič in Zagreb, Musical Evenings at St Donatus in Zadar, the Korkyra Baroque Festival, the Narodni dom Maribor chamber cycle, the Ostinato International Chamber Music Festival Ormiš, the "BEETHOVEN-plus" Festival in Zagreb, the Chamber Music Festival in Čakovec, the Josip Klima Days in Varaždin, the Sfumato cycle of HRT Choir and others. David began working as an accompanist after his studies, first as an external associate at the Zagreb Academy of Music, and since 2022 he has been working as an accompaniment teacher at the Varaždin School of Music.

Iste je godine pobjednik natjecanja Lions Grand Prix u Rijeci, gdje također osvaja i nagradu publike. Laureat je 18. međunarodnog gudačkog natjecanja Rudolf Matz u Čakovcu i dobitnik Muzičke nagrade Grada Čakovec. Dobitnik je također i nagrade Fonda "Stjepan Šulek" povodom čega bilježi nastup uz Zagrebačke filharmoničare, a nastupao je kao solista i uz pratnju Zagrebačkih Solista, Orkestra Muzičke Akademije Zagreb, Hrvatskog baroknog ansambla i Simponijskog orkestra Lichtenstein. Dobitnik je Dekanove nagrade 2022. godine.

Matej Mijalić was born in Rijeka, Croatia. At the age of eight he attended violin classes and graduated both primary and secondary music school at the "Ivan Matetić Ronjgov" Music School under tutelage of Danijel Trinajstić. At the age of twelve he enrolled at the "Kurs für Hochbegabte" at the University of Music and Applied Arts in Vienna at Marina Sorokowa's class. In 2022 he graduated at the Zagreb Academy of Music in the class of Orest Shourgot. During his education years he won numerous first prizes at National and International competitions: Croatian Music and Dance Students Competition in 2012, 2014, 2016 and 2018; "Daleki Akordi" Split, Croatia 2014; "Tirando Pizzicato" 2015; "Svirel" Gorizia, Slovenia in 2017 and 2018. He is the Absolute winner of the "Young Virtuosi" competition in Zagreb in 2019 and also won a special award which was assigned by Croatian Society of Composers. In the same year he won The Lions Grand Prix competition in Rijeka, where he also won The audience award. He is also Laureate of the 18th Rudolf Matz International String Competition in Čakovec and winner of The Music Award of the City of Čakovec. He was also the winner of the award of "Stjepan Šulek" Fund, for which he recorded a performance with Zagreb Philharmonic Orchestra, and he also performed as a soloist with Zagreb Soloists, Orchestra of the Zagreb Academy of Music, Croatian Baroque Ensemble and Lichtenstein Symphony Orchestra. He is awarded with The Dean's Award in 2022.

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
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
